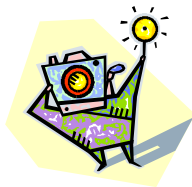

**The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ)** is the state's environmental protection agency. The TCEQ strives to protect human health and the environment by implementing laws that address clean air, clean water and the safe management of waste. In addition to regulating and enforcing environmental laws, the TCEQ provides technical assistance and information on these issues through the Small Business and Environmental Assistance Division. Activities include hosting workshops to provide information on compliance, pollution prevention, waste reduction, and innovative technologies. One outcome has been their award-winning work with TxDOT and the subsequent approval of mulch and compost as a construction BMP by the TCEQ and US Army Corps of Engineers. It is currently working with the Texas Association of Builders to demonstrate these BMPs for their projects. Continued efforts such as these are expected to expand the traditional markets for compost and mulch suppliers for revegetation, erosion and sediment controls. To help facilitate this, the TCEQ maintains a list of composting facilities who may be interested in receiving additional wood waste materials to keep up with demand. 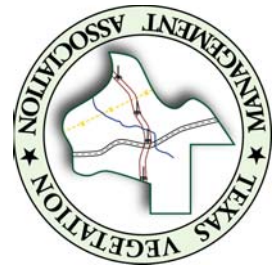
