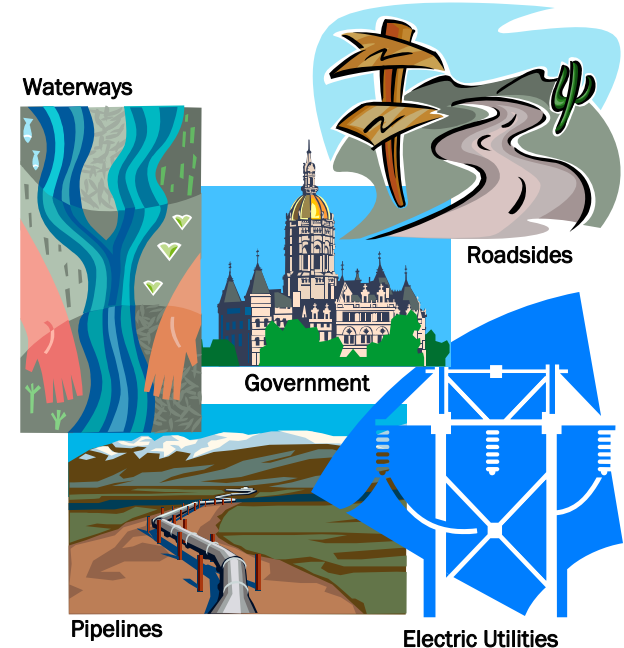

TVMA

TVMA was established in 1992 when a group of managers recognized the need for fostering statewide training and professionalism within the state's vegetation management industry. Since then, TVMA membership has grown steadily to include a broad scope of vegetation managers and other workers who keep our Rights-of-Way soundly managed throughout the diverse ecologies of the Lone Star State.

TVMA is composed of a volunteer Board of Directors who oversee Standing and Special Committees. Each of these committees are managed by TVMA members who lend their special expertise in the following areas:

SCHOLARSHIP: each year TVMA awards monetary scholarship to deserving college-level students hoping to pursue a career in a vegetation management-related field.

LEGISLATIVE: we strive to be the voice of the vegetation management industry. Educating the public, business and community leaders in the issues critical to vegetation managers is an ongoing TVMA effort.

MEMBERSHIP: membership has grown steadily over the years, especially since expanding our training functions.

TRAINING: each year we hold an Annual Conference & Training Seminar where outstanding speakers are assembled to give you the most up-to-date information on vegetation management, and prepare you to take the pesticide applicators license. The Texas Department of Agriculture pesticide applicator license examination is administered on-site during each annual conference. Each annual conference also awards Continuing Education Units (CEU's) from the regulatory agencies. Additionally, TVMA sponsors and facilitates additional training seminars throughout the year across the state of Texas.
